BACKGROUND

John Pointon and Sons are the UK's largest single site rendering and recycling facility. They provide waste disposal, recycling and environmental solutions for animal by-products and food waste.



The company, which employs more than 200 people in their state of the art facilities across Staffordshire, is the only UK based recycling and rendering company to obtain both ISO14001 and OHSAS 18001 Environmental and Health & Safety accreditations.

John Pointon and Sons use their Permit to Work system for managing Working at Height, Hot Work, Confined Space Entry and some Excavations.

CHALLENGES

- High volumes of PTWs created across several large facilities.
- Each PTW managed in isolation - required an overview of all ongoing Permits at the entire facility or across facilities.
- High volumes of approvals, workflows and closeouts to manage using paper-based system.
- Admin burden of the existing paper-based system.
- The need to maintain a paper audit trail for maintaining their ISO and OHSAS accreditations.

SOLUTION

- The existing paper-based system was replaced by Pisis PTW Permit to Work Software, which covers the whole workflow of PTW creation, approvals, closeout and retrieval.
- Help with setup and customisation by Pisis, using existing Permit to Work Questions and workflows to allow a seamless transition to the new system.
